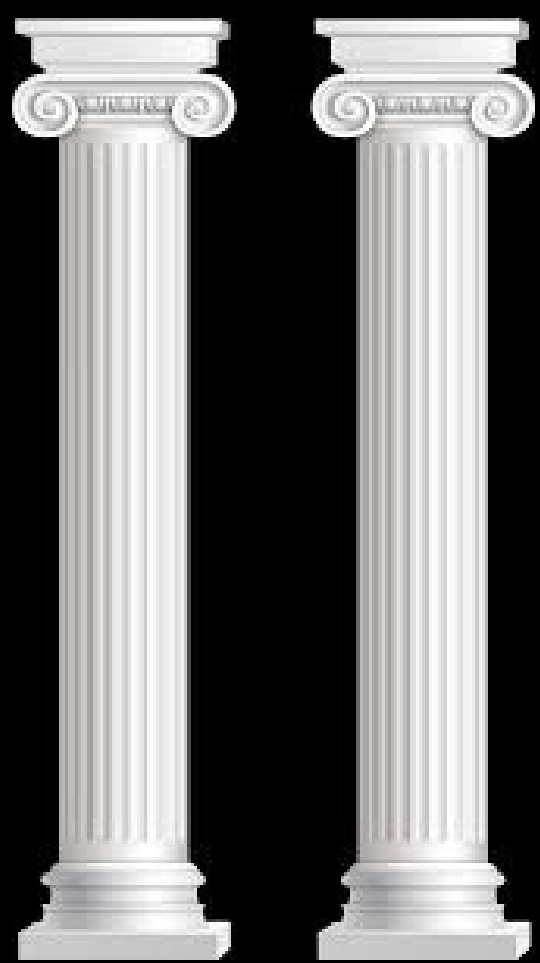

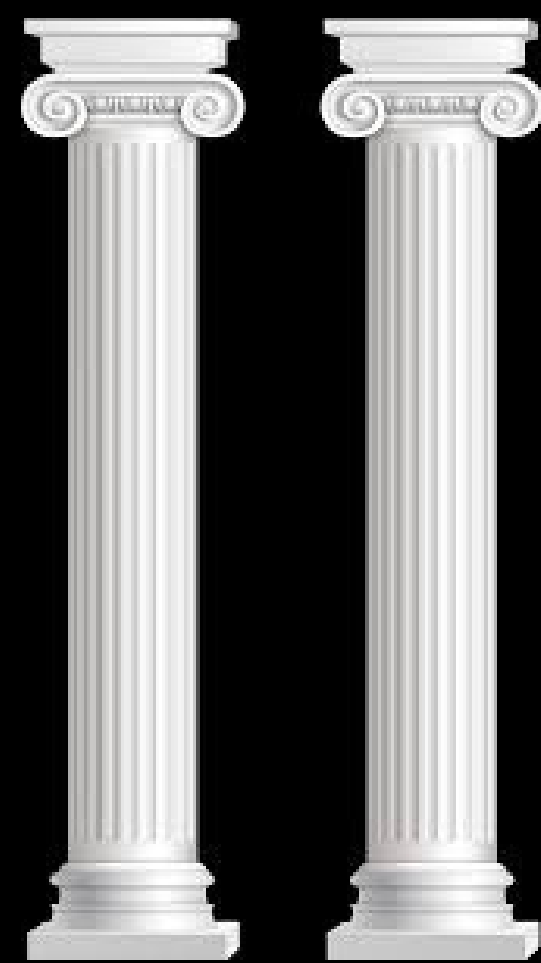

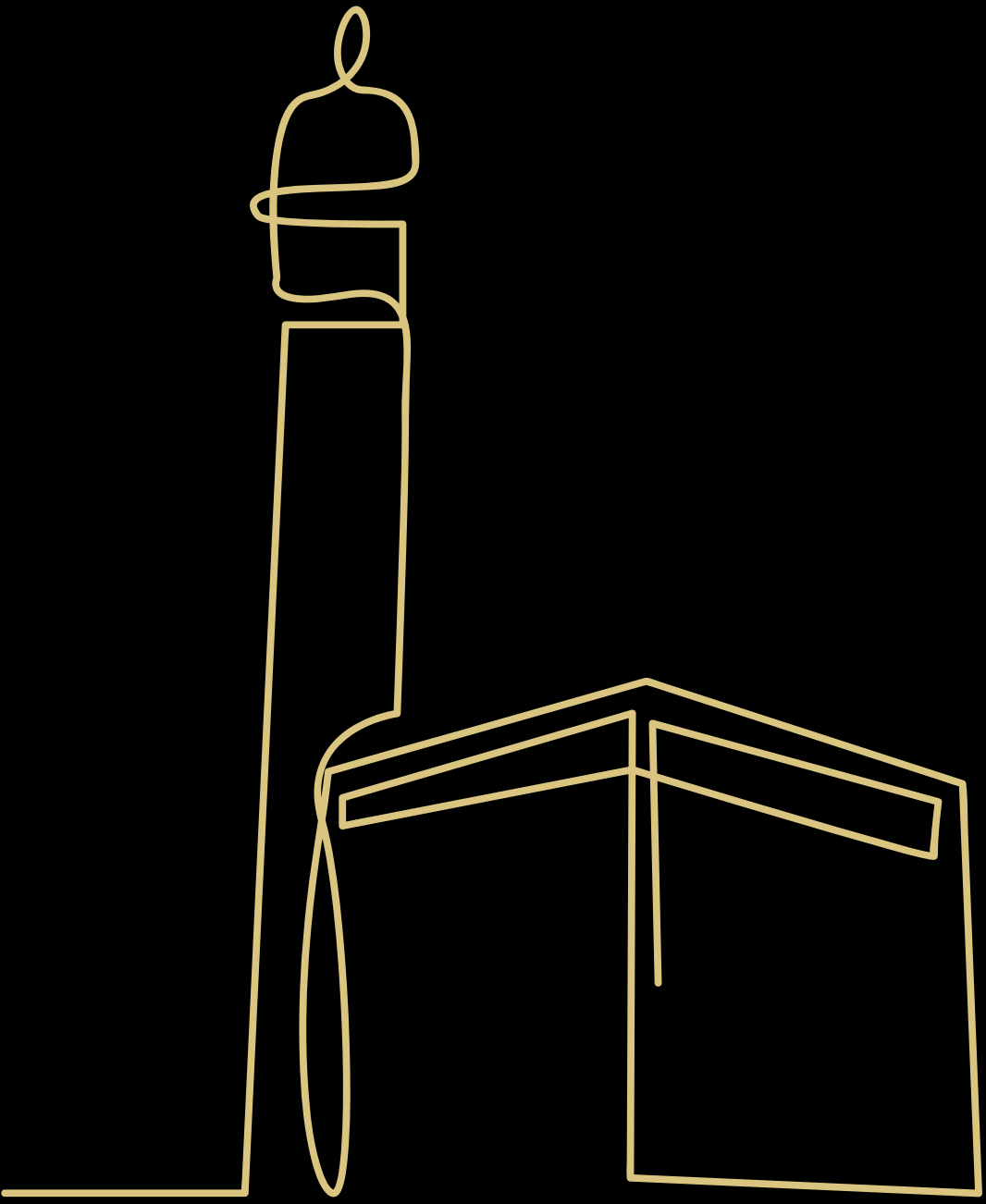
CREATION OF THE ANGELS



ALLAH CREATED THE ANGELS FOR A WISDOM WE DO NOT FULLY KNOW, WE KNOW SOME OF IT BUT WE CANNOT FULLY GRASP IT, HOWEVER WE KNOW THAT THE ANGELS - JUST LIKE THE REST OF CREATION - HAVE BEEN CREATED TO WORSHIP ALLAH AND ALLAH ALONE. THAT'S THE MAIN REASON FOR ALL OF CREATION, TO WORSHIP ALLAH AND ALLAH ALONE, ASSOCIATING NO PEER OR PARTNER WITH HIM. HE IS ALLAH, THE ONE, THE ONLY ONE.

TO BELIEVE IN THE ANGELS IS ONE OF THE PILLARS OF IMAAN, IT IS MANDATORY TO BELIEVE IN THEM., ALLAH CREATED THEM, AND THIS IS FROM THE MATTERS OF THE UNSEEN.

JIBRA'EEL, MIKA'EEL, ISRAFEEL ETC. ALL LITERALLY MEAN ABDULLAH.



Population of the Angels

The angels worship Allah with no hesitation or slacking, they never get tired or lethargic.

The seven heavens are trembling and groaning, the Prophet (peace be upon him) said, the seven heavens are trembling, groaning and shaking. It is befitting for it to tremble, because of the heavy load of angels there, there is not the space of four fingers there except and until you find an angel standing in prayer humbly, bowing in prayer, an angel prostrating, or worshipping Allah, and they've been in that position/state since Allah created them. And on the Judgement Day they will be raised and erected, they will say to Allah, 'Glory and praise be to you O Allah, we did not make a just estimate of you such as due to you' - We did not worship you enough, we didn't do enough!

Since the beginning of creation, every single day 70,000 angels go to visit the frequent house and make tawaf there and they never get the opportunity to return back! They never get the chance to return back because there is always a new batch visiting it every single day! That's how many angels there are! The frequent house to the angels is like the Ka'bah to the humans, it is sacred. It is placed right in the centre, if it were to fall down it would land directly on top of the Ka'bah. The Prophet (Peace be upon him) saw Baitul Ma'mur (The Frequent House) during his ascension.

The minority population on Earth are the humans, the Jinn are approximately ten times more than humans, and the angels on Earth are multiple of the population of humans and Jinns combined!

Characteristics of the Angels

The angels have special characteristics, they have been created from illumination and they are very strong. They are the most powerful creation of Allah.

Jibreel took Qawm Lut (Sodom & Ghamoor), all the cities on one of his wings, carried them all the way up to heaven until the angels could hear the voice of the rooster and the children crying, then he threw them upside down.

The angels are powerful and stern, they carry out the commands of Allah with no hesitation. They never reject any command, rather they hasten to the obedience of Allah, and remain in a forever state of being in awe of Him.

They have wings, some have 2-3 wings whilst others have more. The Prophet one time saw Jibreel in his true form, he said, Jibreel has 600 wings which cover the entire horizon! The Prophet (peace be upon him) couldn't see the horizon anymore!

Angels have the ability to take form (of good). Such as the angel who took the form of a sahaabi to ask the Prophet a question. Also, the angel who went to Maryam (peace be upon her) in the form of a man. When Jibreel (peace be upon him) took human form, he resembled Dihya bin Kalbi (may Allah be pleased with him) the most. Dihya bin Kalbi was one of the most handsome men amongst the Companions of the Prophet (peace be upon them all).

GENDER:

IT IS UNKNOWN WHETHER THE ANGELS ARE MALE OR FEMALE, BUT WHAT WE DO KNOW IS THAT THEIR CREATION IS NOT LIKE THE CREATION OF THE HUMANS, SO NO GENDER IS ATTRIBUTED TO THEM.

Assignment of the Angels

Allah assigned certain tasks to specific angels, like Jibreel is the master of the angels, he is the angel in charge of conveying the revelation to the Prophets, Israfeel is the angel of the trumpet, he has been assigned to blow the trumpet which will commence the beginning of the Day of Judgement, Ridwaan is the gate keeper of Jannah and so on and so forth.

When they are assigned a task, they hasten to carry out the task set to them by Allah. When Allah wants to command the angels to carry out a task, He will speak and all of heaven including the angels will fall swoon – because of the Mighty of Allah's speech. Everything will be scared and will fall swoon.

Allah speaks any time He wants; the Quran is His words. When Allah wants to command he will speak and the heavens will shake, it'll be like a thunder bolt, when this is heard by the angels they fall swoon, they will remain in that state of unconsciousness until Allah removes the shock from them. The first one to wake up will be Jibreel and Allah will command him with the task. He will go to the angels and they will ask him, what did your Lord command? The angels are divided into groups in the heaven, Jibreel is the master of all of them, Jibreel will wake up, then Allah will command him to execute His command – whatever it may be e.g., a tyrant to be alimanted, a town to be destroyed for a river to flow etc., what it is, it will be told to Jibreel.

Jibreel knows the different angels and their tasks, he will go to the certain group of angels to carry out the specific assignment and will speak to the leader among them, Jibreel will inform of the assignment from their Lord and the leader of the group will convey to the rest of the angels with him the assignment.

IN HEAVEN THE GATES ARE LOCKED, BUT THE ANGELS TRAVEL, JUST AS HUMANS HAVE A WAY TO TRAVEL, LIKEWISE ANGELS HAVE THEIR OWN WAY OF TRAVELLING WHICH THERE IS NO COMPARISON OR SIMILARITY DRAWN. THE ANGELS WILL TRAVEL FORM GATE TO GATE ON THEIR WAY TO CARRY OUT THE SET TASK/ASSIGNMENT, DURING THIS THE ANGELS TALK TO EACH OTHER. IT IS DURING THIS PERIOD, THE SHAYATEEN STACK UP ON TOP PF EACH OTHER TRYING TO HEAR OF THE ASSIGNMENT, HE ONLY HEARS A LITTLE WORD, IT IS WITH THIS WORD THEY MIX 100 LIES – THIS IS HOW THE MAGIC OF THE FORTUNE TELLERS WORK.

MIKA'EEL IS THE ANGEL IN CHARGE OF THE RAIN. WHEN IBRAHIM (PEACE BE UPON HIM) WAS THROWN IN THE FIRE, HE KNEW, CERTAINLY ALLAH WILL NOT LET HIM DOWN, ALLAH WON'T LET HIM BURN! MIKA'EEL WAS PREPARING THE RAIN, HE WAS ANTICIPATING THE COMMAND OF ALLAH TO EXTINGUISH THE FIRE WITH THE RAIN. HOWEVER, ALLAH SAVED IBRAHIM HIMSELF! ALLAH SAID, O YOU FIRE, COOL... BUT ALLAH DIDN'T STOP THERE, IF ALLAH STOPPED THERE THEN IBRAHIM WOULD HAVE FROZE TO DEATH! ALLAH SAID, O YOU FIRE, COOL AND PEACE (BE PEACEFUL TO IBRAHIM). ALLAH SAVED HIM WITH HIS WORD!

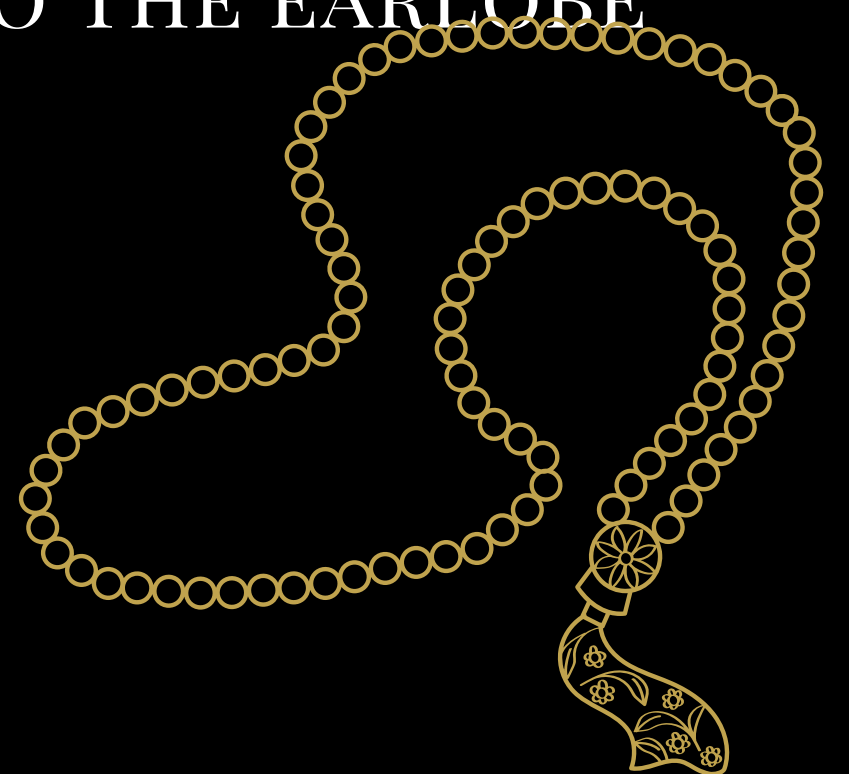


SPECIAL STATUS OF THE ANGELS

ON THE DAY OF JUDGEMENT, THE FIRST TO COME WILL BE ALLAH, THEN THE ANGELS WILL FOLLOW AFTER HIM IN SUCCESSION IN ORDER OF HEAVEN, LINE BY LINE, FORM THE FIRST HEAVEN, THEN THE SECOND HEAVEN, THEN THE THIRD HEAVEN, THEN THE FOURTH, FIFTH, SIXTH, AND THEN ALL THE ANGELS FORM THE SEVENTH HEAVEN. THEN ALLAH WILL COMMENCE THE JUDGEMENT BETWEEN THE PEOPLE. THE ANGELS ARE A SPECIAL CREATION OF ALLAH, AND BEYOND THE COMPREHENSION OF THE HUMAN BEINGS, TO BELIEVE IN THEM IS AN OBLIGATION OF FAITH, A PILLAR FROM THE PILLARS OF IMAAN AND FORM THE MATTERS OF THE UNSEEN – WHATEVER WE HAVE BEEN INFORMED ABOUT WE HEAR IT AND WE BELIEVE IN IT WITH FULL CERTAINTY, WHATEVER HAS NOT BEEN MENTIONED WE DO NOT ATTRIBUTE IT NOR DELVE INTO IT.

WHEN THE VERSE IN THE QURAN WAS REVEALED, THE PROTECTORS OF HELL ARE 19 ANGELS, ABU JAHL BEGAN TO MOCK THE QURAN, JUST LIKE ALL THE EVIL REJECTERS OF FAITH DO.

ABU JAHL SAID TO HIS COMPANIONS, I WILL SUFFICE YOU BY TAKING ON 18 ANGELS, YOU JUST TAKE ON ONE. THE PROPHET SAID IN A HADITH, THOSE ANGELS WHO CARRY THE GIGANTIC DIVINE THRONE OF ALLAH ARE 8, ALLAH GAVE ME PERMISSION TO SPEAK AND DESCRIBE ONE OF THEM! THE DISTANCE FROM HIS EARLOBE TO HIS SHOULDERS WAS THE DISTANCE OF 700 YEARS! HIS FEET IS IN THE LOWEST EARTH AND THE DIVINE THRONE ON HIS SHOULDER, AND BETWEEN THE SHOULDER TO THE EARLOBE IS SEVEN-HUNDRED YEARS!



Some specific tasks of specific angels

- There are angels who are responsible for carrying the divine throne of Allah.
- There are protectors of the gates of paradise. The head/leader of them is called Ridwaan.
- Every believer has four angels always with him from the beginning all the way until he dies, protecting him.
- There are angels in charge of the questioning of the grave.
- There are angels who write our good deeds and our bad deeds.
- There are angels who defend the believers and fight alongside them.
- We have angels in charge of the rain/weather.
- There is an angel in charge of blowing the trumpet to commence the Day of Judgement.
- There are angels to blow the soul of the baby in the womb at four months.
- The angel of death takes the soul of the deceased.
- During the night of Qadr all night long angels come up and down, from Heaven to Earth and from Earth to Heaven.
- Every single day there is a batch of angels who switch shifts in Fajr and 'Asr.
- There are angels in charge of the mountains.
- There are two angels at each of the seven gates of paradise so Dajjal cannot enter inside.
- 70,000 angels for each of the 70,000 bridles of hellfire which will be bought on the Judgement day.

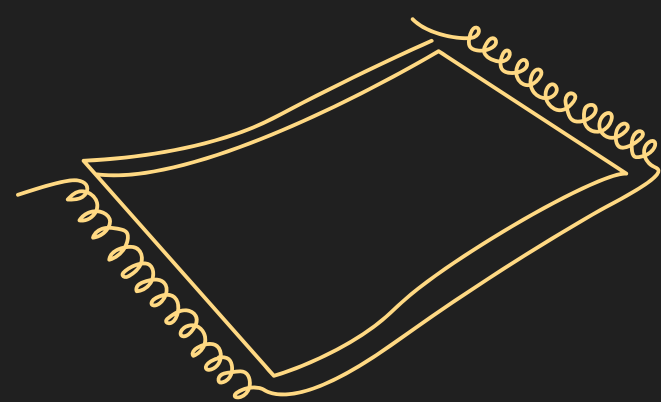
Istighfaar!

There are certain actions the believers can do in order to get the angels making istighfaar for them, for example: coinciding your Ameen with the Ameen of the angels. When you eat Suhoor, the Malaaikeh (angels) make Istighfaar for you. When you visit your sick brothers and sisters, the angels make duah for you. When you make salah upon the Prophet, the angels make Istighfaar for you. When you make duah for your brother/sister, the angels will reply, "Ameen, same for you."

Duty of the Angels

Wisdom of their creation

Allah created the angels for a wisdom we cannot fully grasp or get to know, but we know that just like the rest of creation, angels have been created to worship Allah and Allah alone.



Obedience of Angels

The angels are fully obedient to Allah. They carry out any task assigned to them with no hesitation, their entire creation is a state of devotion to Allah alone.

The Frequent House



Every single day since the start of creation 70,000 angels visit the frequent house and they never get the opportunity to return back to it! That will continue until the Day of Judgement.

The frequent house is in the exactly in the center of heaven, if it were to drop it would drop exactly o top of the Ka'abh.



Population of Angels

The sky is moaning due to the heavy weight of the amount of angels, there is not the space of four-fingers except you find an angel worshipping Allah.

Population

Their population is known to Allah alone, it is said that the humans are a minority creation, the Jinn are approximately ten times more than the humans, and the angels (on just Earth) are double of humans and Jinns combined together! Day of Ressurrection
